



In-Person Worship in the Sanctuary at Concordia Church In-Person & Live Stream Service at 9am

What does In-Person Worship look like in the Sanctuary at Concordia Church?

For the summer, we will offer worship at **9am on Sundays**. This service will also be livestreamed with the recording available for later viewing. You can find details on [the church website](#).

What are the expectations for participants worshipping in-person?

We are following the recommendations of Public Health & CDC guidelines for the general public. Unvaccinated individuals will continue to wear masks and practice physical distancing. For vaccinated individuals, masks are optional and physical distancing is no longer required. *Please note: we will not be asking for proof of vaccination status. We trust that our worshippers will make the decision to do what is safest for themselves and others.*

We will no longer be requiring temperature checks upon arrival. Full communion returns with both bread and wine, however we will not be using the Common Cup. We will not yet be reintroducing passing of the peace or offertory.

Do I have to register ahead of time for in-person worship?

Pre-registration is no longer required.

I still have concerns about social gatherings at this time—Recommendations?

While we are adjusting protocols in accordance with national and local public health guidelines, we understand that it may still take time for everyone – even those who are vaccinated – to feel comfortable with relaxed protocols. Everyone should make the decision about worship that is most comfortable for them. Virtual worship will continue as an option for our faith community.
