# The Last Supper

## QUESTIONS ABOUT THE STORY

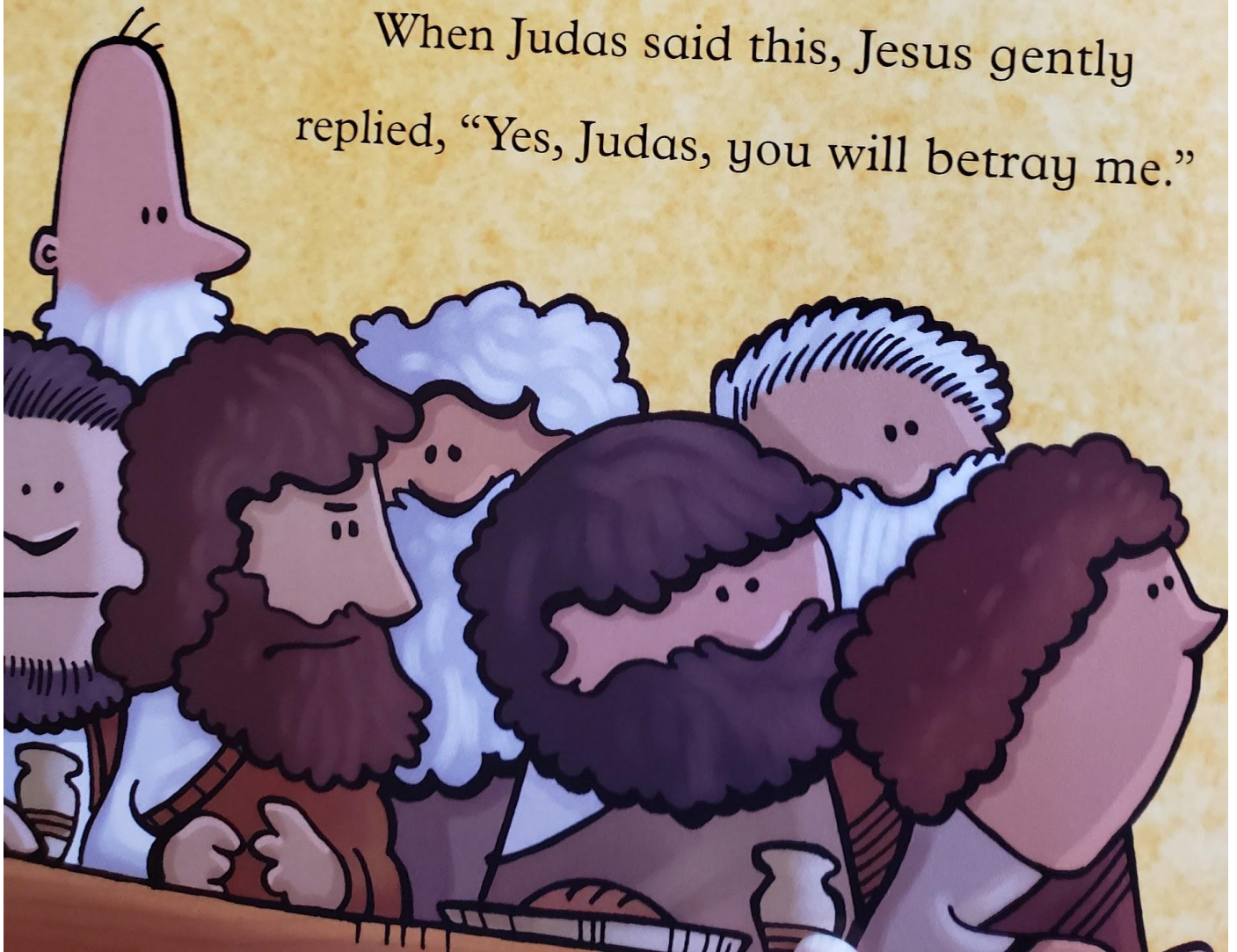
3. At first Peter said, “ You will never wash my feet”, Why do you think he changed his mind?

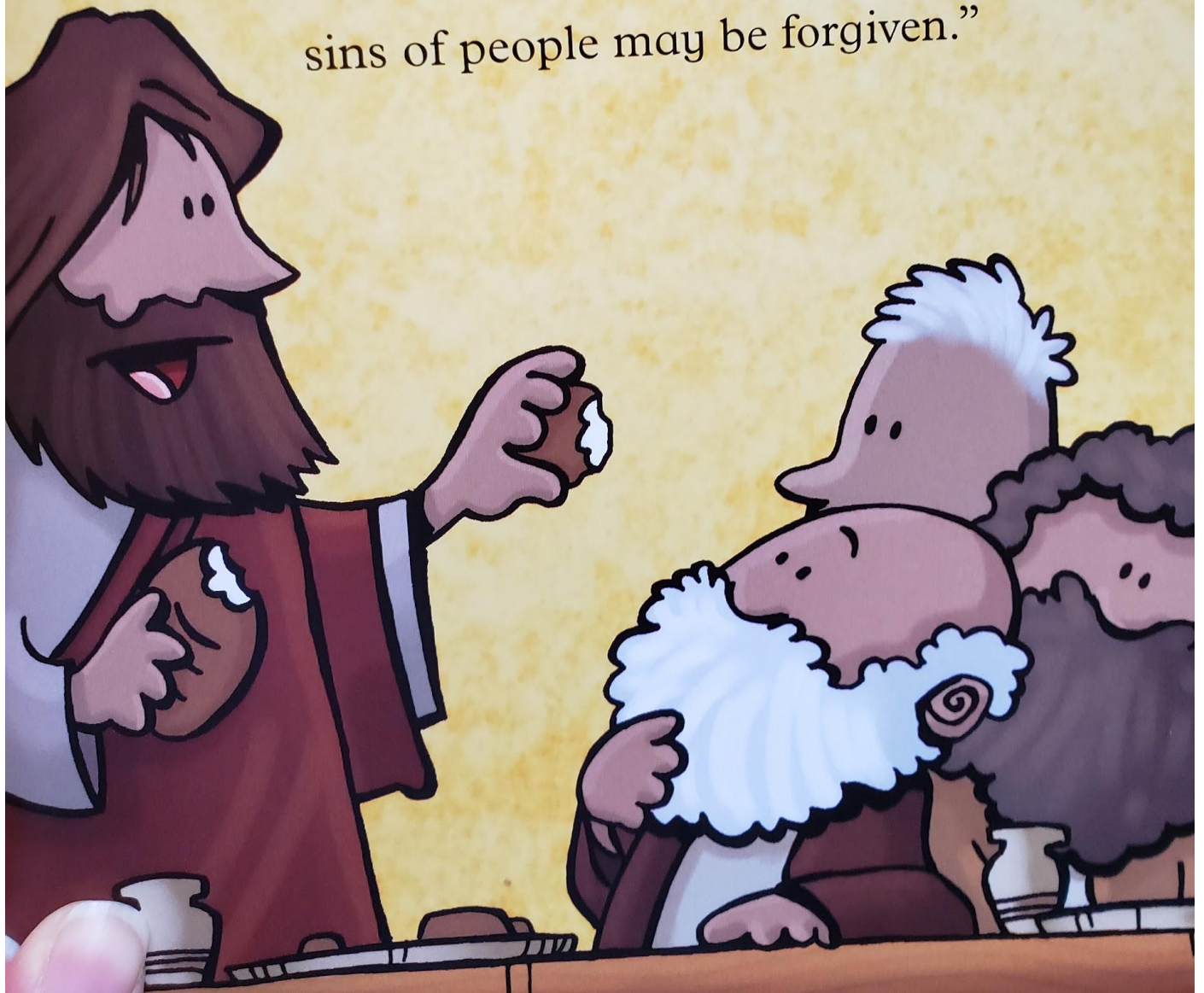
4. Why were the disciples upset?
